- 5. Meeting to discuss, or vote upon entering into an option to purchase, dispose of, or lease real estate. O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(1)(E).
- 6. Meeting to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee, or interviewing applicants for the position of the executive head of an agency. O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(2).
- 7. Meeting of the board of trustees or the investment committee of any public retirement system created by or subject to Title 47 when discussing matters pertaining to investment securities or investment portfolio positions and composition. O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(3).
- 8. Meeting to consider a portion of a record made exempt from public inspection or disclosure pursuant to O.C.G.A. §50-18-70 et al., and there were no reasonable means by which to consider the record without disclosing the exempt portions if the meeting were not closed. O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(4); O.C.G.A. § 50-14-2(2).
